

It begins before birth with good neonatal care and continues after birth with supportive relationships with families and caregivers. Young children acquire social and emotional skills, foundational knowledge, and the dispositions necessary for success in school and beyond through caring connections, early experiences and a ton of play!

Children are not innately "ready" or "not ready" for school. Their skills and development are strongly influenced by their families, through their interactions with other people, and their environments.

Being a school ready child means having the skills, knowledge, and attitudes necessary for success in kindergarten, later learning, and life. This includes all domains of development – physical, social and emotional, language, literacy, and cognitive.

Just as is takes all the ingredients to have a cake turn out tasty, it takes all essential ingredients to be school ready. Supportive families, communities, and schools.
