From Training Office:

Friendly reminder: Please do not submit your Child Care Training courses through the individual training request process. CCT classes will come over automatically from CCT's system. It takes 3-6 days from final grading for trainings to appear in your account.

All individual training requests MUST be submitted within 3 months of the training completion date. If the request is submitted after the 3 months, it will be denied.



In order to be accepted and meet Child Care Licensing Requirements:

- CPR must be completed in a hands on setting and include Adult, Child, and Infant modules.
- First Aid must be Pediatric First Aid.
- CPR/First Aid cards submitted must list ALL information (including Adult CPR) in order to be accepted.

The Montana Early Childhood Apprenticeship Program (MECAP) is a MT Registered Apprenticeship Program designed for Individuals in the early child care and education fields. Apprentices participate in a structured training program and learn both the theoretical and practical aspects of the Job while working. Upon completion, participants earn a Certificate of Completion from the Childhood Development Specialist MT Registered Apprenticeship Program, as well as achieve Level 4 on the Montana Practitioner Registry.
